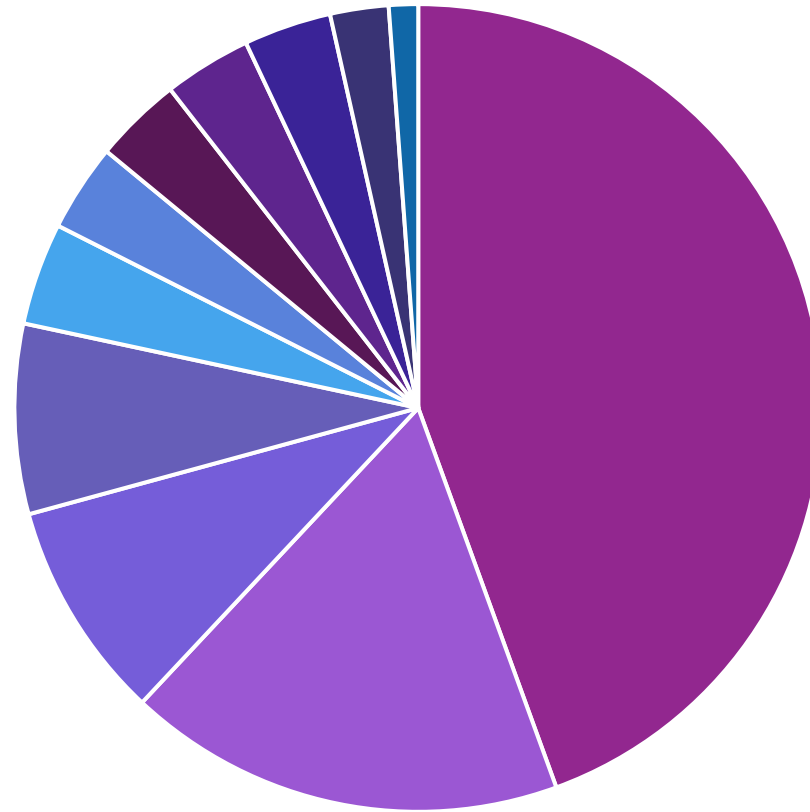
The ITL is...
